



Free Meals for Children during School Closures



Free Meals to Children 18 & Under

Although the resources below are divided by school district, children do not need to be students in that particular district to receive a meal.

TUSD

Starting March 23, 2020, TUSD is offering free Grab-and-Go Mobilized Meals via 12 bus routes making stops at 113 locations between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m., Monday through Friday. Each bus route will include stops at school bus bays and existing bus stops where free Grab-and-Go meals will be provided. Each bus route will stop at the designated school bus bay or bus stop for 10 minutes to provide the Grab-and-Go meals. One breakfast and one lunch will be provided to each child present. These meals are free to all children 18 and under. There are no eligibility requirements--all children 18 and under can receive these free meals. Please note that per Federal Meal Program requirements, children must be present to receive meals. Meals cannot be provided for additional children that are not present.

Sunnyside Unified School District

Starting Monday, March 23, the district will offer grab-and-go breakfast and lunch to all children ages 1-18 years old. Students who show up for breakfast will be able to also take lunch with them, but parents and students will not be allowed to eat on site. There is no need to register for meals and there is no income requirement. The sites, which are listed below, will be open 7:30-10 a.m. Monday through Friday.

Marana Unified School District

The district is offering grab-and-go meal service breakfast and lunch at several sites, but the Marana Cares Mobile service will also continue.

Pick-up stations, which are listed below, will be open Monday-Friday from 7:30-9 a.m. (breakfast) and 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (lunch) starting Monday, March 23 and continuing through the school closure. Children do not have to be part of the district, but they must be present to get a meal. Adult meals are not available. Families do not need to register and there are no income requirements.

Breakfast and lunch will be served for kids ages 18 and under. Children must be present to receive a meal. Starting March 23, breakfast will be served from 7:30-9am and lunch will be served from 11:30am to 1pm at Robles Elementary School, 9875 S. Sasabe Road.

Continental Elementary School District

Students 18 and under can pick up lunch and breakfast from March 19, 20, 23 and 26, regardless if they are enrolled at the school or not. Students can pick up their meals from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. The pre-packaged meals will be consumed at home or offsite to remain in compliance with the National School Lunch Program and school closures.
